Dear Family and Friends,

I am writing this letter to you, so that you might be informed of what has recently been brought to my attention. As of this month, there is only enough money in my God's Helping Hands account to cover 1 to 2 months of my salary. Over the past couple years, the account has built up from monthly support and one-time gifts from generous people like you. But since joining the ministry part-time in 2009 and receiving a monthly salary, the incoming support is not enough to cover the outgoing check each month and has brought the account down a little bit each month to its current condition.

My part-time yearly salary is \$13,000, but records show that only 40% of that comes in each year. When put like that, it truly is a miracle from the Lord at just how He has provided! He is Faithful. I never once have gone hungry or not had a place to stay. I know He will continue to take care of me and provide for me even though I'm not aware how. I must trust Him for the unseen.

I have applied at a local daycare to try to supplement some of my needs. Things are looking positive at the moment. I've already had an interview and am waiting for my background check to come back so I can have a classroom interview with the children. Although, this said, the job would only be very temporary. Our GHH team has a full summer schedule of ministering to camps and churches. Starting in June, I will be on the road traveling for 3 months, which I love to do and which is my first priority.

As of now, I'm not sure what the fall holds for me. I do know that I cannot sign another lease at the end of August. I do not have the means of paying rent for another year. I have been fervently seeking God's will. I do not want to do anything that He does not have planned for me. The **safest** place is in the center of God's will, but that's not always the **easiest** place.

I would ask that you prayerfully consider helping me out financially with a one-time gift or monthly support, if you are able. Some of you who are reading this are already supporting me on a monthly basis and I am so thankful to you!! Whether you can give or not, I would greatly appreciate your prayers during this time. I need wisdom and perseverance. Thank you for taking the time to read this letter and hear my concern.
