Since my last letter, the Lord has been moving me slowly forward with life. I have been able to keep very busy with the Reach More project. As of late November, we were making plans to finish up Phase 2, which was the floor insulation, the placement of the in-floor heating and pouring the cement in the studio area. The Lord provided the funds for the completion of Phase 2, and on December 11th, it was completed.



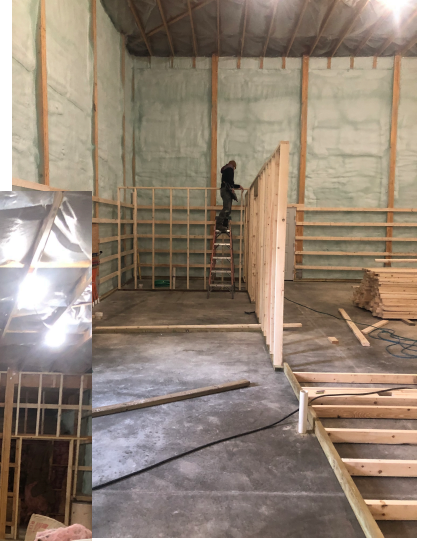
As January came, the Lord was already providing for Phase 3. In early February, the preparation of the studio walls were ready for spray foam insulation. Due to a cancellation with the foam company, they were able to schedule us the next day and had the insulation completed on the 7th and 8th. PTL!



The Lord had provided enough finances not only for the insulation, but also some of the lumber cost for the interior walls of the studio, sound room, storage area, equipment room and rest room along the west wall.



I, and two volunteers, started on 22nd of February and continued the following week. On Monday the 26th, I got a text that two more men were coming, provided by my contractor, and would be helping to frame the interior walls. It didn't take long for them to go through the material I had delivered. The next thing I see is more material being delivered, so the men could keep going. They were there until all the rough-in for the entire building was completed. They finished on the 28th of February. The contractor provided the material until the Lord sends the funds in for the Reach More account.



As you can see, things are moving along faster than I had thought, but our timing is not the Lord's timing. The funds for the contractor have already been coming in and Phase 3 will be complete.

Phase 4 will start very soon, beginning with electrical installation and then moving on to the rest of the sound insulation, hanging and finishing drywall and doors. God is good all the time!
