

The next few months have so much planned and so much to look forward to. Our schedule all the way up to December is filled up and requests for 2027 are already being booked. The 2026/2027

We have been working on saving and raising money to replace our 12 passenger van. We have \$38,000 of the estimated \$40,000 need raised. This van has been working hard for us towing either our equipment trailer or the travel trailer that Nicole and I live in during

the summer and fall months. When we purchased the van, it had 60,000 miles on it, and unbeknownst to us at the time, was exactly what we would need down the road when we started pulling the travel trailer. We specifically need another Chevy Express 3500 12 passenger that is rated to pull 10,000 pounds. I have not been able to find any other full size van that is capable of filling its shoes. Please pray that the rest of the funds needed come in and that we can find exactly what is needed- 3500's are mainly work vans so it is hard to find them as passenger vans. God knew what we needed before we needed it back in 2014 and He has the exact one picked out for us again. The travel trailer had a water leak in the slide out so this spring part of the subfloor in the slide out will be getting replaced. The bus is in need of some repairs as well. Please pray that the problem with the generator will be figured out and fixed along with a couple other mechanical issues the bus is having. Thank you so much for being a part of my support team! Your support through prayer and financial giving allows me to do the work God has called me to do.



After a few years of staying in Michigan for the winter, my parents asked me to drive them out to AZ. It took us four days of driving but we arrived safe and sound at their rental.

The next couple of days I helped get them settled in and then we celebrated Christmas with a good friend that lives around the corner from their rental.
