Mount Everlast: Focusing on things that last forever

God's Helping Hands is preparing the launch of our 2025–2026 series, Mount Everlast! Our theme verse will be 1 Corinthians 3:14, "If the work that anyone has built on the foundation survives, he will receive a reward." To give a little context, Paul, in this passage, is addressing strife in the Corinthian church as divisions had sprung up with different groups declaring their spiritual devotion and lineage to either Paul or Apollos. Of course, as Paul points out in verse 7, it is God who gives spiritual growth. HOWEVER, God does give reward to His servants who build upon the foundation of Christ. This lesson applies to the spiritual investment we place in others (vs. 8–15) and also to the spiritual investment we allow the Holy Spirit to make in us – the temple of God (vs. 16–17). But in order for this growth to happen, we need to eliminate our own wisdom and the wisdom of the world and humble ourselves, allowing the Holy Spirit to build on His foundation with His Word. 2 Peter gives us a fantastic framework of spiritual growth that we will be utilizing in this series. Through it, we will be teaching children to supplement their "faith with virtue, and virtue with knowledge, and knowledge with self-control, and self-control with steadfastness, and steadfastness with godliness, and godliness with brotherly affection, and brotherly affection with love."

Here's a suggestion on a practical way you can join us in prayer as we present this

series: Take these 8 spiritual disciplines (faith, virtue, knowledge, self-control, steadfastness, godliness, brotherly affection and love) and spend a prayerful week on each, asking the Holy Spirit to grow you through His Word. Eight weeks of growth as you pray for the ministry of GHH! Won't you consider it?

How can I partner with GHH?

Short term needs:

Computer Updates: We are close to meeting our goal to bring all our computers up to date. Only \$1,000 to go out of a \$10,000 goal!

Vehicle Replacement:

Our 12-passenger van that tows our trailers needs replacement. We need a GM Chevy Express 3500 12-passenger with a towing capacity of 10,000 lbs. To help toward this need, the ministry is selling its 2010 Chevy Traverse.

Equipment Trailer:

After 15 years, our equipment trailer, as they say, "owes us nothing"! A replacement will cost around \$7,000.

Long term needs:

Bus and Trailer Maintenance: Keeping these behemoths road ready takes a lot, (the bus recently required a leveling valve which cost about \$2,000) but it is still the best way to send the Knobloch team out from May through October. In

addition to the "vehicle stuff", these are also homes for several months and need "home stuff" as well like occasional appliance and furniture replacements.

Reach More Building Project: God continues to confirm His plan as the new building's interior construction rushes toward completion! The finances are in place for drywall! Once that is completed, as the Lord provides, we will tackle finishing the interior; from paint, floors and plumbing fixtures, to doors, trim and light fixtures, everything AND the bathroom sink falls under this phase! The estimated cost is \$14,000.

General Fund: Help us "keep the lights on"!

Missionary Staff Support:

Each of our staff are supported by faith through the generosity of God's people. Some of our loyal supporters have been called to their eternal reward and we trust God will raise up those who would continue their work of prayer and support.

- 6. Set/Prop Design and Painting: We are seeking creative minds and hands with artistic skill.
- 7. Puppet/Costume Design and Building: We are seeking creative minds and hands with artistic and sewing skills.
